Scholastic-Chess

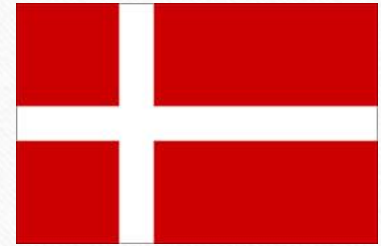
1. Scholastic organisation – not a chess organisation

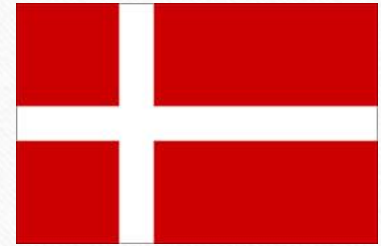
Help children, parents, and society

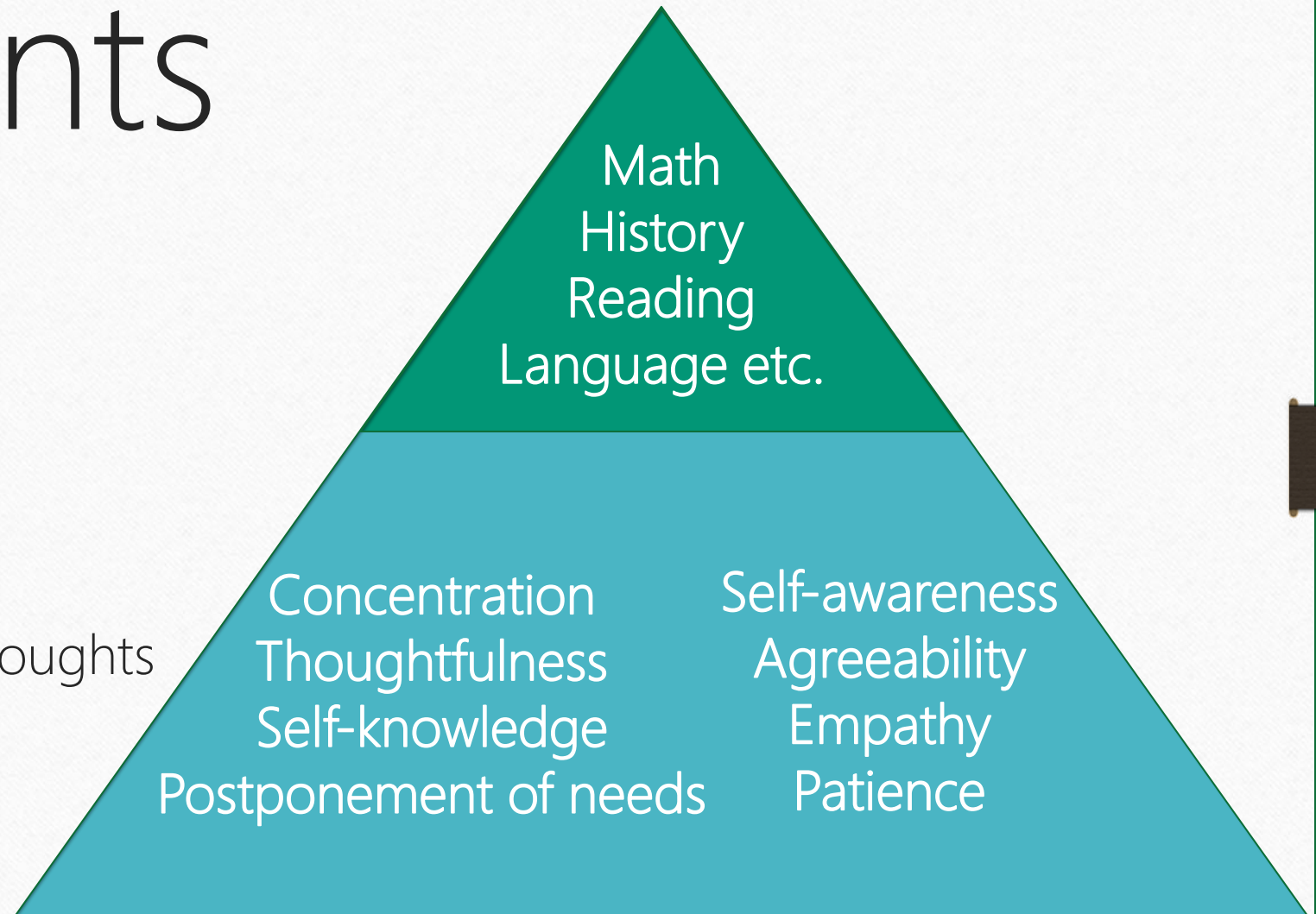

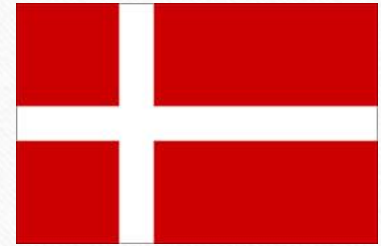

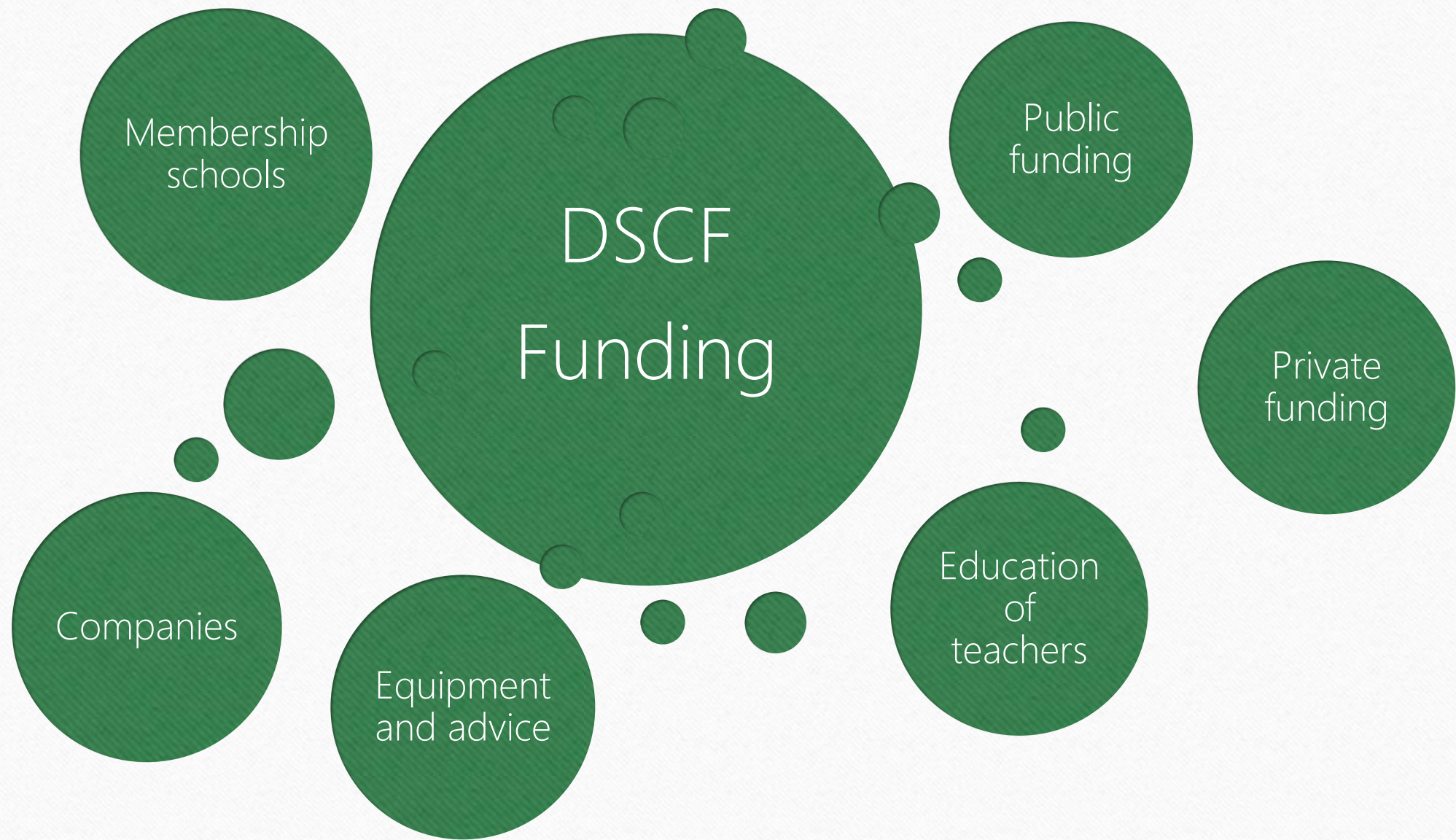




Strategy
